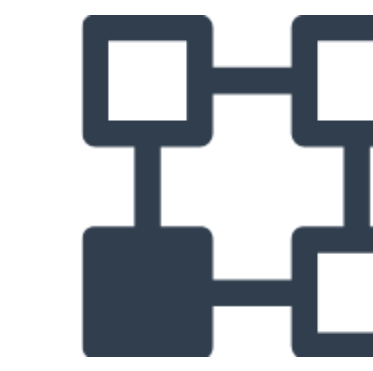

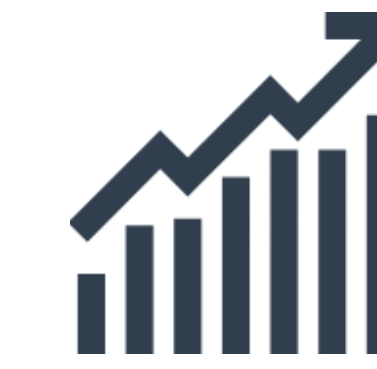

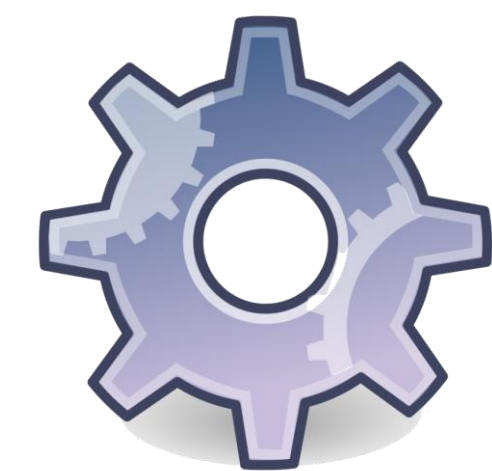
Provide Inquiry Opportunities

Project Ownership: Allow students to develop understanding and learning through teamwork



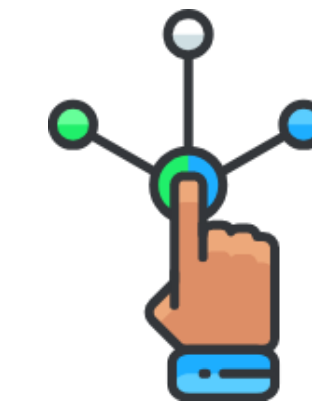
Project-Based Internships

Skills to promote student interest and academics toward success



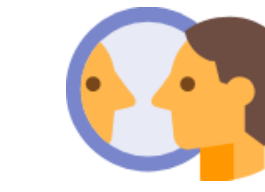
Project-based Learning

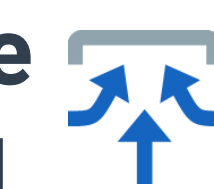
